SEPIA Finance Committee Meeting Minutes for November 16, 2023

Meeting opened at 7 pm with the Serenity Prayer and Introductions

- Read and discussed Tradition 1 and Concept 1
- Reviewed Financial Reports: Monthly Income Statement (P&L), Year-to-Date I/S, Balance Sheet
 - OCTOBER MONTHLY P&L
 - Fran still needs to complete Bank Reconciliation
 - Discussed large inventory adjustment (prior year issue). Impacted monthly bottom line. And yearly bottom line.
 - Reviewed committee and office expenses
 - OCTOBER YTD FINAL YEARLY INCOME STATEMENT
 - Increase in revenue noted in literature and contributions.
 - Discussed variances in yearly expenses in COGS

- Unplanned deficit because of literature costs (increases) and less net revenue in fund raising.
- 10,000 deficit related to the inventory adjustment in addition; committee and office expenditures were less than budgeted.
- Should be noted that figures are not finalized.
- BALANCE SHEET
 - It appears that literature inventory is now accurate.
 - Accounts payable number looks high.
 - Again, the end of year numbers have not been finalized yet.
- OFFICE MANAGER REPORT (Jay)

 - Website is being worked on—working on back end registration initially.

- Meeting is the 1st Monday of the month. Hybrid. SEPIA office and Zoom.
- 25 people at the meeting including online.
- Liaison's reports 3 present.
- Introductions of newcomers (name, homegroup, did you complete the form?) *post form link in chat
- Explain what the CPC is/ what volunteers do, eligibility and what newcomers can expect to do next
- 3 new people signed up for CPC.
- 36 students, from Drexel, were assigned for the month of October. All were escorted to meetings.
- Students have access to ALL reading materials. The AA suggested readings (The Drs Opinion, How It Works, AA Preamble) are provided on their FPC1 course page. Do not suggest anything additional unless the student asks for it. When we "suggest" additional literature/videos, etc we actually put Drexel Medical School's accreditation at risk. They are allotted 1½ hours for this entire process, including readings. Their administration must account for every minute of work they assign and can lose their accreditation if they exceed certain time restrictions. This also applies to our pre and post meeting. Meet for no more than 15 minutes before and after the AA meeting.

- If the students have questions post-meeting and/or the volunteer sends out something they requested, that's OK. Lorie suggests if there's anything that you feel is an important reference post meeting she's happy to post that as well as a 'Post meeting reference'.
- If the students don't respond when the escort reachs out to them, the escort needs to let Lorie, Mike and Steve know. It proved to be very helpful and alleviates scrambling at the end of the month.

- Escorts can reach out to students and ask for copies of their assignments (a 1 page paper they are required to write about their experience with the CPC). We are looking to publish one in the Grapevine to make known the difference SEPIA is making in the medical community.
- HR Summit was discussed. This is a recurring workshop where Human Resource representatives share best
 practices. Alcoholics Anonymous could participate. Richard Avery from HR Summit attended our meeting to
 explain their program. Question were brought up about having to pay for this service, attraction versus
- promotion, anonymity and the possible perception that AA is endorsing HR Summit. These will be investigated in the future.
- Reflection papers were addressed. One of the students felt they were being pushed to submit their reflection paper. It was decided, going forward, we will no longer ask for the reflection papers. Instead, we will create a couple of questions, on their website, the student has the option to answer, regarding the information contained in their reflection paper. They will also have the option to submit the full paper with their personal information redacted.
- A budget of \$800 was approved at our September meeting. This will be voted on with the SEPIA budget at the next Steering Committee meeting.
